Apples

<i>Early</i>	<i>Early-Midseason</i>	<i>Midseason</i>
Gravenstein **	Fuji	Cosmic Crisp
Red McIntosh	Spartan *	Honeycrisp
Yellow Transparent *		Akane

For cross-pollination, choose varieties in the same or adjacent columns

* Varieties are partially self-fertile but benefit from a nearby pollinator

** Varieties are sterile and require two cross-pollinators

Pears

<i>Variety</i>	<i>Pollinator</i>
Anjou	Bartlett or Bosc
Bartlett	Anjou or Bosc
Bosc	Bartlett or Anjou
Shinseiki	Self-fertile

Cherries

<i>Variety</i>	<i>Pollinator</i>
Bing	Rainier or Van
Rainier	Bing or Van
Van	Bing or Rainier
Sweetheart *	Self-fertile

*Also a good pollinator for other varieties

Plums

<i>Variety</i>	<i>Pollinator</i>
Italian Prune	Self-fertile
Beauty	Self-fertile

Peaches

<i>Variety</i>	<i>Pollinator</i>
Frost	Self-fertile
